

What is the Kemp scheme?

It is called SES funding. It means funding for each child is based on the socio-economic status (SES) of where the child lives.

This is the first time school funding has been based on actual student needs, rather than assumptions about “school” wealth.

This SES funding principle is applied within the Independent sector. Even so, the poorest Independent students are still granted at most 70% of a rich student’s (or any student’s) allotment in a state-run school.
